The Authentication system


This is where you sign in with your unique username and password.

- Access to your University email account.

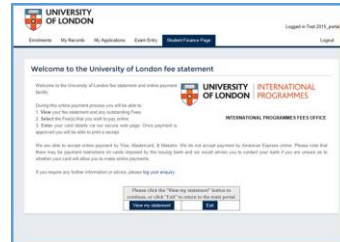

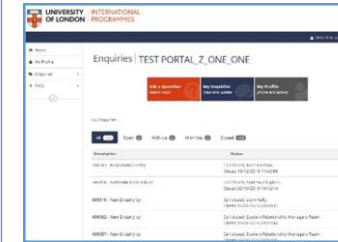

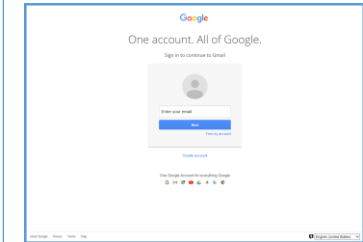
